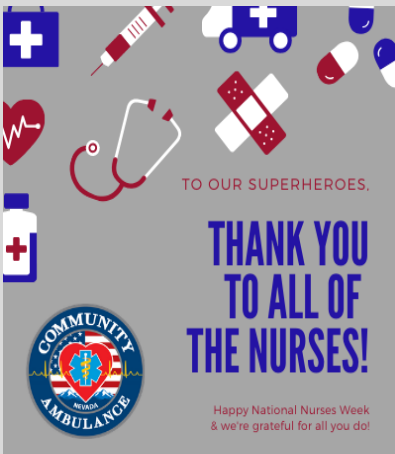

On behalf of all our frontline EMS professionals, we would like to extend our sincere appreciation to everyone at the facilities we serve for their support and encouragement as we respond to COVID-19 patients and other 9-1-1 emergencies. We also recognize your selfless dedication to your patients and the extra compassion you show them during this national health crisis. We are truly in this fight together.

The Las Vegas valley's citizens have shown a tremendous adaptability and compliance with not overcrowding our medical resources during this time of quarantine. And we also appreciate how our medical facilities have done their part to keep facility patients healthy and "sheltered in place." However, we all know that your high-risk patient populations will still need to be transported to hospital EDs as a result of medical emergencies or exacerbations of chronic illness. When that happens, we have a variety of transport options to meet your patients' needs. For example,

24/7 Critical Care Transport: Emergency (Lights/siren), non-urgent, pre-scheduled:

- If a patient requires a ventilator or IV dripped medications that cannot be discontinued, the patient must be transported by a CCT ambulance.

We staff our critical care ambulances with a CCT-Nurse or CCT-Paramedic. CCT-Nurses and CCT-Paramedics have all successfully completed additional training so they may administer medications beyond a paramedic's scope of practice.

24/7 ALS transports: Emergency (Lights/siren), non-urgent, pre-scheduled:

- Paramedic staffed ALS ambulance transport
- Required if patient requires being connected to a cardiac monitor

We staff our ALS ambulances with SNHD certified paramedics and AEMTs.
